Destination Future allows youth and adults from across the United States, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico to come together to discuss and address issues on how to engage youth in systemic change. We will discuss involving youth in Child and Family Services Reviews, case plans, stakeholder meetings, workforce preparation, and collaboration with state agencies. Youth learn and practice leadership skills, and become advocates for themselves and others.

Who should attend?

Youth: Ages 16 through 21 who are receiving independent/transitional living services, and have demonstrated leadership abilities.

Supporters: Social workers, foster parents, youth workers, and volunteers.

Maximum Ratio: Youth must be accompanied by a supporter – a maximum of 3 youth to 1 supporter. Supporters are responsible for the young people they bring.
